Census 2021 Reminder

The next census of population will take place in May of 2021. Filling out the census survey only takes a few minutes and will make significant funding implications for your community; as funding is based on population and may save you money on your property taxes. Also, it is important to fill out the census survey to avoid financial penalty.



Business License Reminder

As per Bylaw #07-2010 of the Town of Saltcoats, no persons shall carry on any business within the town, unless and until he/ she has procured a license to do so.

Fees for a 2021 Business License with the Town of Saltcoats -\$40.00

Business with the R.M. of Saltcoats- \$40.00

Any other business—\$60.00

Failure to comply shall constitute an offence under Bylaw #07-2010, with the first offence being a minimum \$50.00 or a maximum \$200.00 penalty.

As per Bylaw #01-2017, a Bylaw to Restrict the depositing of snow on Street of Right of Ways.

"Street Right-of-Way" means all or any part of a road allowance, public highway, road, road street thoroughfare, lane alley, walkway and sidewalk. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited, ice/snow on any street right of way.

Recycling and Garbage

Please be mindful that recycle materials are clean and not contaminated with items that are NOT recyclable.

The Town of Saltcoats was fined \$56.25 for household contamination recycle and \$75.00 for roll off recycle contaminated cardboard in January.

Pet Licenses for 2021

It is mandatory for any person residing within the town who keeps, possesses or harbors any dog and/or cat, to obtain a pet license. Pet License fees for 2021 are now due.

For the safety of all persons and animals involved, please ensure your pet has been vaccinated for rabies within the last 2 years.

Dog & Cat Licensing Fees:

Males: \$25.00, Females: \$25.00, Spayed or Neutered pet: \$10.00

Required Information for a License:

Proof of vaccination for rabies within the last 2 years.

Proof of spaying/neutering if applicable (if not already on file).

Color photo of pet (if not already on file).
