TOWN OF SALTCOATS BYLAW NO. 02-2010

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SALTCOATS RESTRICTING THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN TYPES OF BUSINESS WITHIN THE TOWN OF SALTCOATS

The Council of the Town of Saltcoats in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. The Town of Saltcoats shall not allow certain types of business to operate within the boundaries of the Town.
 - a. No vehicle or equipment salvage operation shall be permitted to operate within the Town of Saltcoats.
 - b. No storage of scrap vehicles or equipment shall be allowed within the boundaries of the Town of Saltcoats.
- 2. Vehicle Body Shop owners/operators shall be required to house all non-operational vehicles and parts thereof in a neat and well kept building or behind a well maintained fence where such vehicles and pieces of equipment are not visible from street, alley, or neighbouring properties.
- 3. Used vehicles or equipment offered for sale by any licensed dealer shall be attractively displayed and fully operational.
- 4. Notwithstanding the above, it is recognized that certain individuals may have, as a hobby, the restoration of antique vehicles or equipment. These, in restored state, may be attractively displayed on private property. It shall be understood that vehicles and equipment in process of being restored or awaiting restoration, shall be housed in a neat and well kept building or behind a well maintained fence where such vehicles and pieces of equipment are not visible from street, alley, or neighbouring properties.

THIS Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
