The Cemetery Committee is undertaking extensive upgrades and renovations and would appreciate your support! According to Bylaw No. 09-2018, "The Fire Pit Bylaw", no person shall set, cause or allow to be set, an open-air fire within the Town of Saltcoats without first having obtained a permit from the Town Office.

Permits are issued on an annual basis and will be in effect from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The cost of the annual permit is \$20.00 per address.
