

Notice: Refer to Section 219 of *The Planning and development Act, 2007*. Applicants may be entitled to appeal the terms and conditions of a permit issued for a Discretionary Use, or the refusal of an application for a Permitted Use. In order to start an appeal, applicants must, within 30 days of date of Council's approval of a Discretionary Use with terms and conditions, or of the date of a refusal of an application for a Permitted Use, send a written notice of appeal to the Development Appeals Board, c/o P.O. Box 120, Saltcoats, SK. S0A 3R0.
