**Reminder for Building Permits**

Any building - including tarp sheds - and decks that are 100 square feet and over require building permits.

**Fire Pit Permits**

Don't forget to get your annual fire pit permits. They are \$20 per address. Per Bylaw 09-2018, no person shall set, cause or allow to be set, an open-air fire within the Town of Saltcoats without first having obtained a permit from the Town Office.

**Utility Rates Increase**

Bylaw 05-2024 and Bylaw 06-2024 were passed by Council in May. Residential utility bills will increase by \$24 per quarter to a total of \$339.

**Saltcoats Historic Cemetery Rejuvenation Project**

Some progress has been made on aspects of the Rejuvenation Project.
