Saltcoats Historic Cemetery

Many of you have a strong interest in our Saltcoats Historic Cemetery. For some, it is the place where family members and friends were buried and/or are memorialized. For others, it is a place that tells the story of this community and our province. For many, it is a source of community pride - well maintained through the decades, with a self-guided historic tour and a place to visit and reflect. Currently we have three requests.

- 1) As part of the rejuvenation project we need to renew the depleted soils of the three flowerbeds. If you have access to well rotted manure, ideal for this purpose, we would appreciate a quantity donated and delivered to the cemetery before the planting season begins.
- 2) Our Advisory Committee needs new members. We will very much miss the expertise and energy Robert Morgan brought to our work over recent years. The Committee is named, and is responsible to, Town of Saltcoats Council. The cemetery has served a large rural area and Council can appoint persons to the committee who are neither residents nor ratepayers of the Town. That of course is in addition to persons who are residents or ratepayers of the Town! Please consider volunteering.
- 3) While several important steps have been taken re the Cemetery Rejuvenation Program, there is much to do. Please consider donating to the program or making a further donation if you can. And, please remind family, friends, former residents or their families of how important and appreciated their donations also are.
