TREE PLANTING

Rooted in Care: Tree Planting (From the Saltcoats Beautification Committee)

Our trees are a vital part of the com-
munity's beauty and spirit. Thanks to
the careful planting and ongoing care,
our town continues to grow greener
every year.



Three main methods have helped
shape our treed landscape:

- **Straight Row Planting:** Trees planted along a culti-
vated strip, weeded and watered for several years to
encourage strong early growth.
- **Row Planting with Mulch:** Trees planted into grassy
areas and heavily mulched with wood shavings —
while more expensive, this approach reduces the need
for watering.
- **Row Planting without Mulch:** Trees planted directly
into grass with no additional watering or mulching —
the most cost-effective method, especially for spruce
and pine species.

A Friendly Reminder: When mowing or trimming near
trees, please take care not to damage the bark. Healthy bark
protects against insects, disease, and rodents, helping our
trees thrive.

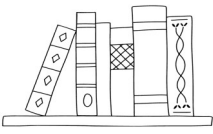
